

Weston Hills CE Primary School Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Expenditure Statement 2016-17

The PPG is allocated to schools for the purpose of:

- raising the attainment of disadvantaged pupils of all abilities to reach their potential
- supporting children and young people with parents in the regular armed forces

The national PPG per pupil for 2016 to 2017 is as follows:

Looked-after children (LAC) defined in the Children Act 1989 as one who is in the care of, or provided with accommodation by, an English local authority	£1,900
Children who have ceased to be looked after by a local authority in England and Wales because of adoption, a special guardianship order, a child arrangements order or a residence order	£1,900
Pupils in year groups reception to year 11 recorded as Ever 6 Service Child or in receipt of a child pension from the Ministry of Defence	£300

£23,800 Teaching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide additional teaching hours for small group interventions and 1:1 support opportunities from Teaching Assistants. • To provide Pastoral Care support for pupils and families including a 6 week child psychology course for parents.
£1000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To purchase subscriptions to websites which children can access both at home and in school to support their learning in Maths and English. • To purchase additional resources to support teachers in delivering the curriculum and assessing children's next steps in their learning.
£1200	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To facilitate subsidised places for pupil premium pupils in Breakfast Club
£1800 CPD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide professional development and training for teachers • To take part in Catch-Up Numeracy national research project – staff release time for training and additional TA hours to deliver the intervention.
£1000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To facilitate subsidised places for Pupil Premium pupils on trips and residential visits
