The post is temporary until assistance is no longer required and/or upon successful completion of a six month probationary period or as a result of the child leaving the school, whichever is the earliest.

We are seeking to appoint a 1:1 teaching assistant to support a child in Year 4 with Downs Syndrome/Special Educational Needs. The child you will be supporting has medical, physical and sensory needs and requires support to access both the indoor and outdoor learning environments enabling her to integrate with her peers as fully as possible.

The role will involve:

- Using Makaton to support and develop communication
- Working 1:1 and in small groups with the child to provide support for her additional needs, enhance her development and facilitate her inclusion
- Liaising with the child's parents, class teacher and the SENCO
- Working in partnership with a range of external agencies
- Facilitating the implementation of the child's EHCP

We need someone who:

- Has experience of supporting pupils with medical and/or physical needs
- Has experience of working in EYFS, Key Stage 1 & 2
- Is resilient and able to cope with the physical demands that this post will bring
- Works in a calm, caring and supportive manner
- Can recognise that children need to develop independence to allow them to build on life skills
